Policies:

- **REGISTRATION ON COMMUNITY PASS:** You may register for classes at <https://register.communitypass.net/chatham>. If you are new to the system you will need to create a profile. Simply click create profile and follow the steps. Creation of a profile is required to be able to register for classes.
- **All classes will run from 3:05 to 4:05pm.** Please pick up your child promptly. Parents should be prompt picking up their children and should wait outside the front entrance for them to be dismissed. **Please be aware of our three strike late pick up policy.** The first late pick up is a warning. The second time, you will be fined \$10 payable to MAS PTO, and the third time your child will be withdrawn from the class with no refund.
- If your student will not be attending a class on a particular day, please call the Milton absentee line (973-457-2508) and leave a message. In addition to the absentee line, kindly send a note to your child's teacher or call the office if your child is still attending school that day but not his/her enrichment class. Attendance is taken for all classes and parents are notified of absences.
- **Early Closing/Dismissal:** If school is closed for any reason, ASE classes for that day will also be cancelled. If school is not cancelled, but weather is a factor for the 4pm pick up, then ASE classes will be cancelled. There is one make up class built into the schedule for cancellations.
- **Refunds:** No Refunds are given after classes begin. Medical notes will be considered, but only for partial reimbursement. Refunds will not be offered for missed classes. Refunds will be given if the committee must cancel a class due to low enrollment BEFORE the classes start. Refunds are given if the instructor is not able to complete scheduled class.
- Class spaces are very limited and your child is registered on a first come basis. If a class is already full, you will automatically be placed on the wait list. If enrollment for a class is too low, the class may have to be cancelled.
- Confirmation will be received via email upon completion of registration on Community Pass.
- **CHILDREN WILL BE SENT DIRECTLY AT DISMISSAL TIME TO THEIR ENRICHMENT CLASSES. AM KINDERGARTNERS SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THEIR ASSIGNED ROOMS THROUGH THE FRONT ENTRANCE. ALL ENRICHMENT CLASSES ARE DISMISSED AT 4:05 THROUGH THE FRONT ENTRANCE. PARENTS SHOULD MEET THEIR CHILDREN AT THE FRONT DOOR.** Only those students who have parent authorization to walk home (as per the Daily Dismissal Authorization form) may do so. Work Family Connections students are dismissed into the gym.
- **For Baking and Cooking Classes:** Peanuts and tree nut ingredients are prohibited, however the class may take place in a room that is not "nut free". All allergies (no matter how minor) must be disclosed for any child taking a cooking class. If any information is not disclosed to the ASE staff, the child may be removed from the class and a refund will not be given.
- **PLEASE NOTE: All After-School Enrichment communication regarding class changes and cancellations will be done via email and/or text.** You will be contacted via email and/or text if this happens. PLEASE read your emails from MAS Enrichment so you and your children are informed of any schedule changes and we may direct your child appropriately at the end of the school day. Please be sure your email address and mobile phone is correct in community pass and is checked frequently to be aware of any important class changes.

WINTER 2020 After School Enrichment- FAQs

1. How do I register?

You may register for classes by typing <https://register.communitypass.net> or typing “community pass chatham” into your browser. If you are new to the system you will need to create a profile. Again type “community pass chatham” then simply follow links at the top left of the screen. Creation of a profile is required to be able to register for classes.

2. What should I do if I have a problem signing into Community Pass?

Remember, passwords are case sensitive and you can request an email with your password from Community Pass’s website. If that fails, email masenrichment@gmail.com

3. Why are some classes cancelled?

We cancel classes when there are too few students to run the class.

4. Should I put my child on the waitlist if they don’t get in?

Yes, there is some movement after registration classes and spots may open.

5. Why is there such a wide range of prices for classes?

We use district teachers and outside vendors, their costs vary widely. Also the amount and cost of materials also varies by class. We try to run classes and make a small profit for the MAS PTO.

6. Why are certain classes offered to only certain grades?

There is a huge developmental difference between a kindergartner and a third grader. Instructors decide the grade levels that would get the most from their curriculum.

7. What should I do if I am not sure a class will be in session?

Check the website calendar or your confirmation. Please try to avoid calling the school.

8. What should I do if my child is sick and not going to school and/or enrichment?

Please leave a message on the absence line ([973-457-2508](tel:973-457-2508), press 1), noting that he/she is scheduled for enrichment on that day and will not be going.

9. Can I add information or change who is allowed to pick up my child?

For temporary changes, please call the front office ([973-457-2508](tel:973-457-2508) press 2) and let them know of the change. If you have a permanent change, please email the Main Office at mhollingsworth@chatham-nj.org. The Main Office will notify the instructor of the change.

10. If my child does Work Family can they participate in Enrichment?

Yes, your child will go from their classroom straight to Enrichment class and when the class is over the Enrichment teacher will bring your child to the Work Family room. Both Work Family and the Milton staff onsite are aware of the children who will attend Work Family after enrichment.

11. How does my child get to his/her enrichment class?

Your child’s classroom teacher has a list of who attends each class and the dates of those classes. He/She will dismiss children taking enrichment on a specific day to the specific classroom. PM

Kindergarten students are escorted to their class. AM Kindergarten students should report to the Main Office at 3:00. Once the bell rings, parents may take their Kindergarten students to the enrichment classroom. The ASE class teacher will take attendance. It is important to update the registration system with your child's grade and teacher so that your child is on their teachers' list.
